The <u>University of Cagliari</u> was funded in 1620 by Felipe III, King of Spain, and nowadays it has 6 Faculties, 15 departments, offers more than 80 Bachelor and Master curricula, and 10 of them gave a double degree. Furthermore, the University of Cagliari offers PhD and specialization curricula in most of the disciplinary fields.

The University's activities are located in historical buildings in Cagliari and in the new Campus in Monserrato, well connected by the local transportation system.

Confirming its international vocation, since 2019 the University of Cagliari is a founding partner of the "EDUC - European Digital UniverCity" Alleance, supported by the European Community under the "European Universities" program.

The <u>Department of Electrical and Electronic Engineering</u> is the reference structure of the University of Cagliari devoted, also with the cooperation of other Departments, to the educational and research activities in electrical, electronic and information engineering. It is the proposer of the PhD courses on Electronic and Information Engineering and on Industrial Engineering, the latter in cooperation with the Department of Mechanical, Chemical and Materials Engineering, and both PhD courses have a curriculum on Automation.

The Faculty of Engineering was founded in 1939 and started the teaching activities with the Study Programme in Mining Engineering. The other Study Programmes in Engineering were established later on during the years. In the academic year 2006/2007 the Faculty of Architecture was created due to the specific demand coming from the regional territory and the Mediterranean


basin.



The present Faculty of Engineering and Architecture derives from a deep reorganization of the Italian universities following the national university reform. It consists in a structure joining up 3 Departments: Civil-Environmental Engineering and Architecture; Electrical and Electronic Engineering; Mechanical, Chemical and Materials Engineering.


The new Faculty was born with the aim of creating a synergy between a unique technological environment in Sardinia, represented by the former Faculty of Engineering, with its laboratories and rich relations with the regional industrial system, and the historic and quality cultures of the architectural project.

Nowadays 9 undergraduate courses and 10 Master courses are offered. The three departments of the faculty contribute to offer 6 PhD courses, mainly multidisciplinary, in the various areas of interest.



The campus of the Faculty of Engineering and Architecture in Piazza d'Armi can be easily reached from downtown by means of the <u>public transportation system</u> (lines 5 and 8), and it is at walking distance (*15-30 min*) from downtown.





Near to the campus there is a Bar-Cafè (Web Café) where it is possible to have also salads, sandwiches and pizzas at lunch time.

At walking distance (10-15 min) some others Bar-Café and restaurants can be found.



Traveling to Cagliari

Cagliari is the largest city in Sardinia and national and international flights are available to and from the <u>Cagliari-Elmas Airport "Mario Mameli"</u> (CAG). Living in Cagliari

Usually, the June weather in Cagliari is mild with temperature between 17 and 26 °C, and quite rare rain. Nevertheless, in 2022 we experienced a little higher mean temperature with temperature peaks in the early afternoon.

Cagliari has several B&B, Residences and Hotels where the attendees can stay during the workshop.

Very near to the campus there are two B&B <u>Nùe Rooms</u>, Via Montenotte 12, Cagliari, 09123, Italia <u>Panorama Cagliari</u>, Via Goito 19, Cagliari, Cagliari, 9123, Italia

A little bit farer, but still at walking distance, there are <u>Residence Monte Grappa</u>, Via Monte Grappa 41/A, Cagliari, CA, 9122, Italia <u>Hotel Villa Fanny</u>, Via San Giovanni Bosco, 8, Cagliari, 09123, Italia <u>Mercury Rooms</u>, Viale Merello 27/a, Cagliari, 9123, Italia

All the accommodations that can be found in Castello and Villanova districts are at less than 20 min walk from the campus, and those in Stampace and Marina districts are within 30 min walk, but with nearby bus stops of lines 8 or 5.

Early booking is recommended to have the best prices since in June they start to rise as the high touristic season is approaching.

Castello, Villanova, Stampace and Marina are the 4 districts of the "old Cagliari" where you can find the best options for lunches and dinners, both with regional and international food proposals, and with a large spectrum of prices.

Cagliari offers several opportunities for the leisure time: cultural, artistic, and relaxing.
