

Logistical Information EECI International Graduate School on Control

Venue Address:

ETH Zurich (Zentrum), Physikstrasse 3, 8092 Zurich / Switzerland ETL K 25 (on the top floor)







Directions:

From Zurich Central Station (travelling by public transport)

- From the "Bahnhofstrasse/HB" stop: Tram no. 6 (direction Zoo) and get off at "Voltastrasse" stop (5 stops). Walk downhill from the stop and take the vehicle access road (Sternwartstrasse) going behind the ETZ building. Continue up a flight of stairs to Physikstrasse and the ETL building.
- From the "Bahnhofplatz" stop: Tram no. 10 (direction Airport) and get off at "ETH/Universitätsspital" stop (3 stops). The ETH main building is slightly south of the tram stop. From there you can also walk to IfA via Schmelzbergstrasse and the stairs at the far end.

You will require a ticket that is valid for zone 110 (city of Zurich); cost is CHF 8.60 for 24 hours

From Zurich Airport

By tram

- From the "Zurich Airport" tram stop
- Tram no. 10 (direction Bahnhofplatz/HB) as far as the "ETH/Universitätsspital" stop. The tram runs every 7 to 15 minutes between 6.00 am in the morning and 11 pm at night. Journey time: 30 minutes

By rail

• If you wish to travel from the airport to the city center (Central Station), it is recommended to use the S-Bahn or mainline services. The trains depart from the "Zurich Airport" station. Journey time: approx. 10 minutes

You will require a ticket valid for 3 zones (zone 110 & 121), cost is CHF 13.20 for 24 hours

If you are spending the whole day in Zurich, it is worth buying a day pass (valid for 24 hours). A 24h ticket costs only twice as much as a regular one-way ticket.
